Plastic has become one of the most widely used materials due to its durability and versatility, but this has inadvertently led to the generation of large quantities of problematic and unnecessary plastic waste impacting negatively on our oceans and wildlife health.

Many businesses maintain a sense of moral obligation to take action against plastic pollution and reduce the impact of their operations on the environment. Wood is committed to playing its part towards this global cause and as such has made the following pledge.

In support of the 'Directive (EU) 2019/904 on the reduction of the impact of certain plastic products on the environment', Wood will eliminate all direct purchases (within Wood's purchasing and/or contractual control) by 2025 of the following plastic-based products as a minimum.

- Hot drink pods / condiment sachets
- Disposable plastic / polystyrene cups and lids
- Plastic / polystyrene containers and lids
- Beverage bottles ≤ 3L
- Plastic disposable cutlery, stirrers, plates, cups, bowls and straws
- Envelopes with plastic windows
- Plastic packaging (e.g. polystyrene inserts/filler, plastic wrap, bubble wrap)
- Wet wipes
